

## 2017-2018 Beginning Band Rehearsals & Winter Concert Policy

\*Each rehearsal is worth 1 point (it does NOT count as practice sheet time).

\*The Winter Concert is worth 6 points. **The Winter Concert will be held on Thursday, December 14, 2017, at the Kaimuki High School Auditorium. The concert begins at 6:00pm. Please refer to the itinerary that your child will receive for the specific meeting time.**

\*If your child is unable to attend a rehearsal, needs to leave early, or is tardy, he/she must submit a note from his/her parent/guardian or teacher. Please follow the policy as stated in the KMS Music Department Handbook/Grading Policy. Excuse notes must be given to Mrs. Ochi-Onishi or Mr. Fujio **prior to the start of the rehearsal**. Students who are tardy must give Mrs. Ochi-Onishi or Mr. Fujio an excused tardy slip when he/she returns to the rehearsal.

\***If your child misses 3 rehearsals (for any reason), he/she will not be permitted to participate in the Winter Concert.**

\*Students must make up all missing rehearsal points due to **unexcused** absences and tardies.

\*If your child is unable to participate in the Winter Concert, he/she must make up the concert points by writing a 4 page double-spaced typed report **or** completing a special project approved by the instructor. This includes cases of illness and emergencies. Students with a previous engagement that conflicts with the concert must submit a note from his/her parent/guardian.
