Open House Recap - open house went well, no suggestions for improvements were provided

Believe! Kids Catalog - online sales are currently \$600, due dates for orders are Friday, Sep. 13th. Shipment should arrive sometime in Nov. and pick up of shipment will occur after-school.

Concert Band Auditions - Beginning Band students will take their instruments home this weekend. Intermediate students have already auditioned and their results have been posted this past week.

Rehearsal Schedules - KIB (Kaimuki Intermediate Band), KCB (Kaimuki Concert Band), and KSW (Kaimuki Symphonic Winds) will begin after-school rehearsals this week. KSW will hold rehearsals approximately 3 times/week. The Beginning Band (~170 students) will practice together in the cafeteria. As the winter concert nears, they will be split and hold 3 separate rehearsals. This year, the winter concert will be held in the KMS Cafeteria. In the 2nd semester, they hope to keep the Beginning Band intact for the Aloha Concert that will be held at Kaimuki High. Chorus will begin rehearsals at the beginning of the 2nd quarter.

Wilson Fun Fair (Sat., Nov. 23) - KCB will be performing at this event and will need chaperones to help with moving equipment and setup f event. KCB is smaller this year with 68 students.

Feeder Schools Concert Tour (Wed., Dec. 4 and Tue., Dec. 10) - The tour will feature KSW and the Chamber Strings. Normally, the group will visit Wilson, Waialae, Kahala, and either Liholiho or Waikiki

Winter Concert schedule - This year, due to the uncertainty of when Kaimuki High auditorium renovations would be completed, the music program decided to host the concerts on campus. The music program considering offering up spots to other clubs on campus to see if they'd like to run a concession stand on the nights of the concerts. Beginning Band will be split because of their large size and the small size of the cafeteria. They will play the same pieces.
